ERRATA

Atomic Energy of Canada Limited Application for a licence to decommission Whiteshell Laboratories

Atomic Energy of Canada Limited (AECL) applied to the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) for a licence to decommission AECL's Whiteshell Laboratories. The Commission approved the application and issued Reasons for Decision on December 19, 2002.

The following corrections are made to the *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* issued by the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission on December 19, 2002.

In the section entitled: 4.1.1 Description of the Overall Decommissioning Plan - Page 5; the sentence beginning:

“AECL explained that the first phase, projected to last approximately sixty years...” is changed to:

“AECL explained that the first phase, projected to last approximately six years....”

In the section entitled 4.11 Financial Guarantees - Page 24, the sentence:

“CNSC staff also stated that it is currently seeking a guarantee that consists of a fund that will build over time with the remaining balance of the liability being covered at all times by a government commitment.” is replaced with:

“CNSC staff also stated that, consistent with CNSC policy, the financial guarantee may consist of a fund or government commitment.”

In the section entitled 4.11 Financial Guarantees - Page 25, the sentence:

“The Commission is in agreement with the proposed conceptual structure of the guarantee for this facility, i.e., a growing fund together with a government commitment for the balance of liability.” is replaced with:

“The Commission is in agreement that the financial guarantee for this facility may consist of a fund and/or a government commitment.”
