



Revised Notice of Public Hearing and Participant Funding

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a public hearing on September 26, 2019, to consider an application from the Saskatchewan Research Council (SRC) to amend its Non-Power Reactor Operating Licence for its SLOWPOKE-2 reactor and associated facilities. SRC's SLOWPOKE-2 facility is located in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan.

The current licence authorizes SRC to operate the SLOWPOKE-2 facility and to transition the reactor into a safe state. The proposed licence amendment would authorize SRC to decommission the facility.

In advance of the public hearing, the CNSC is making up to **\$15,000** available through its Participant Funding Program. The purpose of the funding is to assist Indigenous peoples, members of the public and stakeholders in reviewing SRC's application and associated documents, and in participating in the Commission hearing process by providing topic-specific interventions to the Commission. Please note that the \$15,000 will be disbursed among all successful applicants. The deadline to submit a completed participant funding application form to the CNSC is **July 12, 2019**.

Pursuant to rule 19 of the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure*, persons who have an interest or expertise in this matter or information that may be useful to the Commission in coming to a decision are invited to comment on SRC's application by way of written submission, or by way of written submission and oral presentation. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Commission Secretariat by **August 26, 2019** using the online request form or the contact information below. **The request to intervene must include the following information:**

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only or by way of written submission and oral presentation
- the requester's name, address and telephone number

The Commission is considering conducting the public hearing via electronic means. Participants will be provided information on how to participate at a later date.

All submissions will be available for download on the CNSC website at www.nuclearsafety.gc.ca or on request to the Secretariat. Personal information, such as address and telephone number, is essential for linking the submission to its author. If you wish to ensure the confidentiality of your personal information, please submit it on a separate page.
